Chaparral Vista Dress Code

The Bonita Unified School District and Chaparral & Vista High Schools believe appropriate student dress contributes to a productive learning environment. The standards for dress and grooming strongly emphasize to students that our school is a place of business with high expectations and is concerned about providing and maintaining a safe and effective learning environment that promotes student achievement. Students whose clothing violates dress code guidelines will be provided an opportunity to wear borrowed clothing to be returned at the end of the day. If necessary, parents/guardians will be contacted and expected to provide appropriate clothing.

What To Wear	What Not To Wear
 Clothing sufficient to conceal all undergarments Pants or shorts that sit at the waist without a belt and have an inseam longer than 2 inches. Overalls with both straps buckled Skirts and dresses that reach mid-thigh or longer. Leggings or biker shorts thick enough to be considered pants or if sheer, worn with a shirt or dress that covers to mid-thigh. Hair bands Leather or plastic belts Plain belt buckles Sneakers, leather shoes, boots, flip-flops, opentoed sandals, backless shoes, shoes with hard soles. Earrings Bracelets Watches Clothing (including hats/beanies) that represents a Bonita Unified school (Chap/Vista, SDHS, BHS gear) or clothing brand logo (Nike, Adidas, etc.) Jogging outfits, sweats, flannel shirts and pants Uniforms Medically/religiously required head coverings as approved by school administration Hoods when the weather is 64 degrees or lower outside. (May not be worn in doors) 	 Shirts that reveal the rib cage or chest area, and midriffs. Pants, shorts, dresses or skirts that do not cover the buttocks/undergarments, or stay up without a belt. (i.e. sagging) Visible under garments Leggings or biker shorts that are see-through. Strapless tops or tube top tops Low-cut tops Lingerie-style tops Bandanas or combs in hair Belts or wristbands with protruding metal Wallet chains Any clothing that depicts violence/weapons, profanity, alcohol, tobacco, drugs or gambling Any clothing (graphics and logos) that depicts cultural/religious/sexual prejudice, or is sexually suggestive in graphics, pictures or words Any clothing (including hats/beanies) that represents a sports team that is not part of Bonita Unified (Chap/Vista, SDHS, BHS gear is ok) Any shoes without hard soles Steel-toed shoes or boots Blankets Hoods when the weather is 65 degrees or higher.

Final interpretation of the school dress code is at the discretion of the school administration.

All staff members shall enforce the dress code policy. Students out of dress code will not be permitted to attend classes until they correct the violation.
