
## **Free Online Tutoring**

- 4. Permission Slip for Rehearsal MUST be signed and returned to attend rehearsal and ride the bus. \*Graduates must attend the rehearsal in order participate in commencement ceremony.
- 5. Books & Materials including the chromebook and charger, must be returned or replaced prior to picking up diploma. Preferably, these items should be returned when student has completed all the required credits to graduate.
