
Free Online Tutoring

- 1. Cap, gown, tassel Pick up date to be determined
- 2. Tickets and announcements Pick up date to be determined
- 3. Grad Contract MUST be signed and returned in order to participate in the ceremony
- Permission Slip for Rehearsal MUST be signed and returned to attend rehearsal and ride the bus. *Graduates must attend the rehearsal in order participate in commencement ceremony.
- Books & Materials including the chromebook and charger, must be returned or replaced prior to picking up diploma. Preferably, these items should be returned when student has completed all the required credits to graduate.
- Photos Senior photos with cap & gown will be available on our school site at no cost. Dates: April 9 & 23 by appointment only. Call 909-971-8240 ext. 4050 Digital copies will be emailed to you.
- Guests Each student receives 10 tickets for the ceremony. Guests will not be given entrance without a ticket. All guests are expected to follow the decorum of the ceremony.

Graduation Day

- Graduate Celebration Assembly and Brunch Arrive at Chaparral at 8:30am with your cap, gown, and tassel for a group photo
- Rehearsal 10:00am Graduates will then be bussed to the BCA for rehearsal (graduates must ride the bus) and will return to campus by 12:15pm
- Decorating of caps is not allowed, neither are any other alterations to the cap or gown.
- Commencement Ceremony Line up in cap and gown at 4:30pm at the BCA – DON'T BE LATE! Commencement march begins at 5:00pm.
- Dress code and school rules will be enforced.
